

## DPP 2012 GUIDELINES FOR MANUSCRIPTS OF 3-PAGE PAPERS

Authors wishing to have short papers of their abstracts published may submit manuscripts for peer-review, followed after final acceptance, by publication in symposium proceedings that will be published as searchable short papers in an electronic supplement of the **Journal of Animal Science**. Authors interested in submitting a 3-page manuscript so indicated on the abstract submission form.

Four key conditions apply:

1. The presenter listed on the abstract must be registered for 2012 DPP by April 6, 2012 and attend 2012 DPP.
2. The presenter listed on the abstract is expected to present the abstract at 2012 DPP.
3. The manuscript of the short paper must be submitted by April 23 at 23:00 CST via the dedicated website. This website will be functional in the next week to 10 days.
4. The corresponding author should not have received a notice during the abstract review process that a 3-page paper will not be accepted.

### **Expectation**

Each corresponding author may receive requests to review up to two manuscripts for each paper submitted. In turn, each manuscript will be reviewed by 2 reviewers.

### **Published format**

The short papers will be restricted to **3 pages** in the special e-Supplement of the Journal of Animal Science.

### **Submitted format**

The peer-reviewed process will focus on scientific content. Manuscripts with improper formatting and/or American English risk instant rejection.

**Important Note:** Especially authors of abstracts that required revisions are strongly encouraged to involve a writer with strong English skills in the writing process.

Each manuscript for the **3 published pages** is limited to **7 total pages, submitted in Word format, double spaced with 1 inch margins and using 12 pt Times Roman font**. This page length is fully inclusive and includes tables, figures and references.

## **MANUSCRIPT STYLE**

Manuscripts should be prepared in the format of the Journal of Animal Science. Click on (or copy and paste) the link below to access INSTRUCTIONS TO AUTHORS for Journal of Animal Science.

Manuscripts should be written in English with double spacing and continuously numbered lines (DO NOT RESTART LINE NUMBERING ON EACH PAGE).

Manuscripts should contain the following sections in this order: Running Head, Title, Authors, Affiliation, Abstract, Key words, Introduction, Materials and Methods, Results, Discussion (or combined Results and Discussion), Literature cited, and Tables and Figures (including figure captions).
